Marianne Goodale, brought up in Lingfield and Dormansland, has always had a passion for singing. She was the lead soprano of Ardingly College Chapel Choir, singing in many prestigious locations including St. Paul's Cathedral, St. George's Chapel, Windsor and Winchester Cathedral. She studied languages at the University of Bath and was an interpreter and translator in her early professional career, singing for pleasure during that time.

Marianne holds a Diploma in Music Performance from Trinity College London. Her recent soprano soloist performances include Part II of Handel's *Messiah*, Vivaldi's *Nulla in Mundo Pax Sincera* and an evening recital at Leiston Abbey, Suffolk. Marianne's future performances include lunchtime concerts in Rutland and Sussex and she is looking forward to joining Hillingdon Choral Society on tour in Luxembourg as the soprano soloist, performing John Rutter's *Requiem* and Handel's *Ode on St. Cecilia's Day*.

Jonathan Hodgson read Music at the University of Manchester and holds a performance diploma from The Associated Board. Jonathan is Assistant Director of Pro Corda, a national music organisation serving 2,500 young people which specialises in small ensemble music training. In addition to teaching, his role includes fundraising, marketing and the strategic direction and management of the organisation.

Aside from Pro Corda, Jonathan enjoys a career as a piano and organ teacher, musical director, composer, organist and accompanist. He has musical directed productions including *My Fair Lady*, *Carmen* and *West Side Story* and has transcribed music for television production company Talkback Thames. As an accompanist, he has worked with a number of singers and instrumentalists, he has toured with choral groups to Paris, Brussels, Venice and Barcelona and accompanied pop opera group G4 on their 2018 Christmas tour.
